Principal's Report:

- Newsela-
 - District funded/PTSG did not need to help with funding as anticipated
 - Students reading HIDDEN FIGURES 1100 lexile level

- “Endless well of materials at lexile appropriate levels”
- Teachers “authentically adopted”/bottom up request
- 2 quizzes per week to accurately measure growth/difficult to test that often
- “Proud to be Principal” of EGJH-
 - Staff is collaborative and capturing kids hearts
 - Engagement highest in Science, then Social Studies, followed by Language Arts and Math
 - Transitioning to “Growth” Mindset from “Achievement” Mindset
 - Major shift for both staff and student belief systems
- Positive Response Letters
 - Required for teachers: every 9 weeks/5 contacts/teacher
- Holiday Outreach projects inspiring
- AdvancED Accreditation Process March 5-6th, 2018
 - 4-5 year cycle Survey/Inventory response for accreditation process
 - Mr. Steiner leading/Mr. Miller summary presentation
