What will school opening look like?

This changes almost daily, it is a fluid situation. What we know: we will institute a rigorous cleaning protocol which will include custodial training and testing. This cleaning protocol requires strict oversight. It will be overseen by an administrator

There will be live classes but we do not know how many people will be allowed in a class

It is uncertain how many parents will send their child/children to school vs online or home schooling. Note: the state funds are based on students actually attending. The state does not currently fund for students attending in an online fashion

EGJH is still planning to open on time

7th grade orientation

likely to take place 2-3 days before start of school

multiple sessions in order to keep groups small

hoping to accomplish as much as possible online such as locker combination/assignment, PE uniform purchase, schedule pick up

Constant Contact: obtaining emails for incoming 7th grade families is very important. May have to be in person sign up at orientation to avoid errors. Carrie suggested having homeroom teachers call students to obtain email

Constant Contact summer editions will be sent every 2-3 weeks depending on content.

Bell schedule changes: 7th period will be Wednesday and 5th period will be Thursday. This is to accommodate teacher travel between locations.
